

Unlikely Heroes Technical Rider & Stage Plan

First of all, thank you for your interest in booking a show for Unlikely Heroes. Below is a list of our technical requirements. If there are any questions or if you have trouble providing any of the below mentioned please get in touch with us before the day of the show and we will work out a solution. If a PA system is provided please read the following requirements:

Our stage setup is:

- 1 Keyboard setup (1 or 2 keyboards)
- 1 Drum set (acoustic drum set)
- 1 Bass Guitar
- 1 Harmonica
- 1 Electric Guitar
- 4 Vocals

We require that there is a quality sized PA system provided for the concert venue with sufficient power to supply a clean and undistorted 110dB SPL RMS to the mixing board and a powerful and feedback-proof monitor system. Four floor monitors is expected or venues over 500 people we will need two extra monitors for the band and two sidefills for really large venues. It would be a big plus if each player could have their own monitor speakers with separate mixes.

Drums – We'll supply two overhead phantom powered microphones with boom stands and a kick drum microphone unless sound crew has a better solution.

Bass and Guitar players can go directly to the board using direct boxes and use a monitor mix. If sound crew prefers amps on stage then band will supply amps. Mics will need to be provided to send guitar/bass signal to the mixing board

Keyboards – One or two keyboards will be used with ¼ jacks to input into the snake via direct boxes then back to mixing board.

Harmonica – will bring personal microphone and go directly to the board/snake using a direct box then back to mixing board

4 Vocal microphones with boom stands.

Floor Monitors – a minimum of 4 monitors is required depending on stage size.

Required lines to audio snake and mixing board with a minimum of 12 inputs and phantom power capability:

- 8 Direct boxes from various instruments explained above to audio snake
- 4 Microphone and XLR cables to snake
- 4 Boom stands for vocal microphones required
